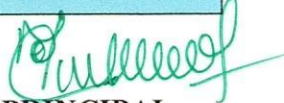
The Heads of the Departments in turn have conducted a meeting in their departments and explored the possibility of action plan to be implemented in accordance with the demands of the stake holders.
